10:00 – 11:00 a.m. **Hospital Readmissions Among US Vets with CHF: A Rural/Urban Analysis**
Kyle Muus, Research Associate – UND Center for Rural Health – Grand Forks, ND

Hospital readmissions for patients with CHF are relatively common and costly occurrences within the US health infrastructure, including the VA health system. Given that little is known about readmissions among rural U.S. veteran patients, Kyle will present analysis of VA data that examined sociodemographics of veterans with CHF who had 30-day readmissions and compare the effect of 30-day post-discharge health service use on these readmissions for rural and urban veterans. Results emphasized the importance of timely post-acute follow-up care for promoting recovery and good health among these veterans.
